Steps to increase participation of students in the improvement of Spoken English & Enrichment of Vocabulary

The following is the action plan for the session 2011-2012 to be followed by all English teachers of IV-VIII standards regarding spoken English & enrichment of vocabulary.

Spoken English

Daily Activity – Attention on pronunciation by class teachers and respective English teachers while conducting the assembly programmes:

- Story telling
- Two minutes debates
- Group Discussion
- Finding difference between two similar pictures
- Constantly monitoring the pronunciation of 's' & 'sh'.
- Appointing spoken English monitor in each class.

Bimonthly Activity – Role play according to instruction on role-play card

- Role play : Telephone call, politely disagreeing describing. (Ex. Families apartment to a potential tenant, trip)
- Running commentary : on a cricket match role.

Sessional Activity :

- JAM – To be conducted at the end of the first session
- Conversation between students on a topic given on the spot.

Note – Different activities can be added according to the discretion and convenience of the teacher.

Encouragement – Through declaring winners and giving them small prizes

Enrichment of Vocabulary

Regular Activity –

- Constant evaluation of textual word meaning through Monday tests.
- Reading a story and writing the moral and meaning of difficult words in the copy.
- Distribution of twenty words with meanings on a weekly basis.

Bimonthly Activity – Conducting a test on the given words in the form of writing the meanings, constructing sentences, rearranging jumbled letters to form meaningful words.

Encouragement – Through declaring winners & giving them small prizes

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
