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**ART, CULTURAL & LITERARY COMPETITIONS – 2022**

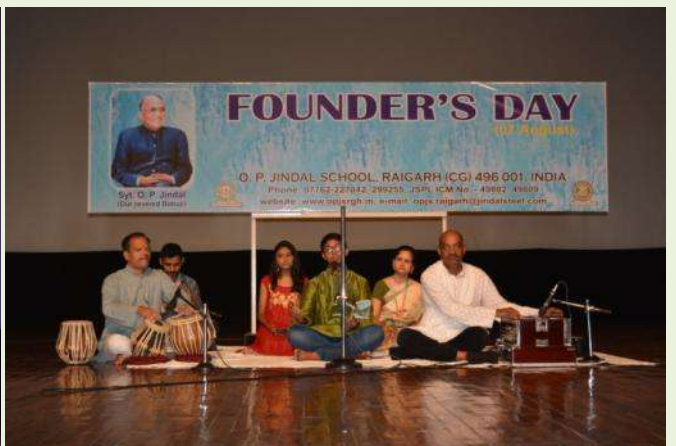
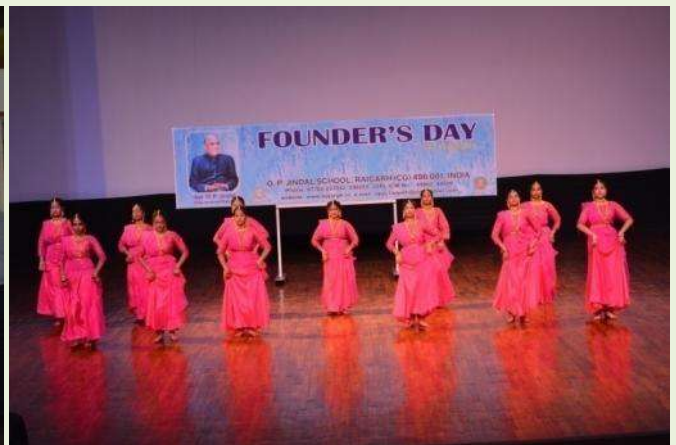

The competition was divided into four categories viz.

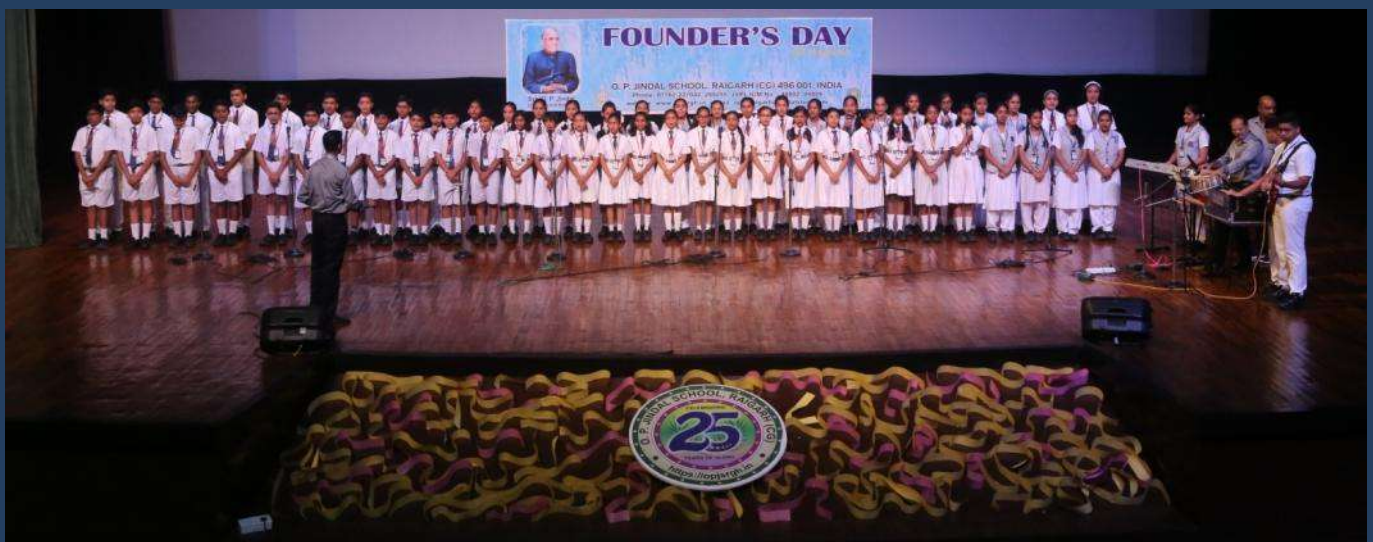
- ❖ English Essay Writing Competition
