




#### **GLOBAL EXPOSURE**

Our school has consistently reached remarkable milestones across various domains, earning recognition and commendation from several prestigious national and international organizations. Some of the key achievements in this regard include:


- Winner of the USO National Painting Competition 2024 (Junior Category)
